- The rewards will change throughout the year, but this is a sample of what it might look like.

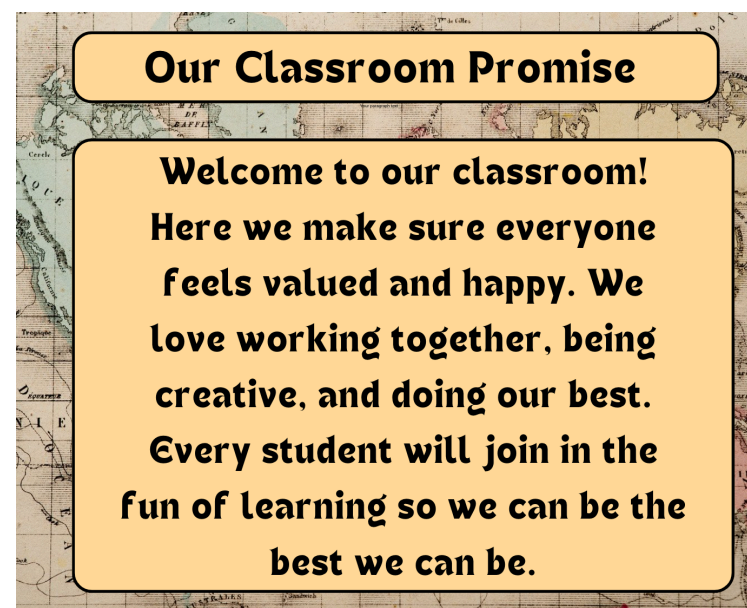


Homework

- **Weekly homework:** review page or fluency
 - Divided into sections for each day
 - Due on Friday morning for reward
- **Read 30 minutes each day** (NOT tracked)
 - Students are encouraged to read books from the Battle of the Books (BoB) list
 - Students should read at least one chapter book from the list each quarter
 - The B.O.B. books read WILL be tracked
- **Book Talk** (1 per quarter). Short, descriptive sharing of a book the student read.
- **Book reports** (1-2 for year).
- **County project**
- **Math fair project**
- **Multiplication fact practice** (NOT tracked)
- **Extra practice assignments** (optional)
- **Make up work** (Absences should be communicated with Mrs. Kartchner)
- **Unfinished work** will be very minimal if time in class is used wisely.

Other Rewards

- Weekly drawing of tickets for earned Mustang Tickets and or class tickets.
- Rewards for homework turned in by Friday morning.
- Rewards based on behavior in rotations.
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Water/ Snacks

- Students should bring a full, spill-proof water bottle each day.
- Water only- no other drinks.
- Snack time will be given at 10:15. Our lunch is at 12:30 so that makes for a long morning. Feel free to send a substantial snack to hold students over until lunch.
- Students should bring single serving snacks.
