Cell Phones / Smart Watches

We follow the Monte Vista school policy which states, "Students should not use cell phones or smart watches during school hours or on school property. Cell phones must remain in backpacks. Smart watches may be worn, but if used inappropriately, teachers may ask they be put in backpacks."

Last year, the 5th grade team had significant problems with smart watches being used during school hours. As a result, we required all students to keep smart watches in their backpacks. I will do the same again this year if it becomes too cumbersome to monitor appropriate smart watch use.
