

Welcome to Second Grade!

- School begins at 8:55. Students should arrive no more than ten minutes early, *unless they are eating breakfast in the cafeteria*. Please make sure students are dressed appropriately for school each day. This includes any weather related clothing. Sturdy shoes for walking or running are encouraged.
- In order for students to stay indoors during recess, due to illness or other circumstances, students need to bring a note signed by a parent. (Air quality and temperatures will be monitored.)
- Lunch/Recess is scheduled from 11:40-12:15 M-Th, and 11:15-11:50 on Fridays.

Your student may go to another teacher's classroom in order to be properly supervised.

Homework

All school information goes home in student's Homework Folder. Please check it daily. A homework packet, that will help to reinforce essential standards, will be sent home each Monday. Homework packets should be returned each Friday. Includes: reading calendar, spelling list, math review, and comprehension page.

Grading Policy

Grades will be determined based on proficiency of grade-level standards for each subject area. I will use traditional Skyward grading skill sets. Updated regularly.

4 4s in any area mean that the student is showing **high proficiency** in that area. Student has an advanced understanding of the standard.

3 3s mean that the student is showing **proficiency** with 2nd grade concepts. Students with a 3 are on grade-level and consistently meet the standard.

2 2s in any area show that the student is **approaching** the standard. Student is working hard, and still needs more work with that specific concept. These standards will continue to be targeted in small groups or one-on-one instruction.

1 Students who have a 1 or NI in any area **do not** meet the standards, and have a hard time understanding those concepts. We will continue to work on these concepts.

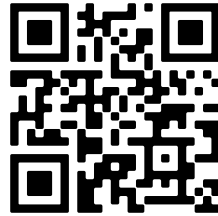
Notice: the items on this list will be used during the regular school day. They may be brought from home on a voluntary basis; otherwise, they will be furnished by the school.
