Grading Policy

Grades will be determined based on proficiency of grade-level standards for each subject area. I will use traditional Skyward grading skill sets. Updated regularly.

- **4** 4s in any area mean that the student is showing **high proficiency** in that area. Student has an advanced understanding of the standard.
- **3** 3s mean that the student is showing **proficiency** with 2nd grade concepts. Students with a 3 are on grade-level and consistently meet the standard.
- 2 2s in any area show that the student is **approaching** the standard. Student is working hard, and still needs more work with that specific concept. These standards will continue to be targeted in small groups or one-on-one instruction.

 1 Students who have a 1 or NI in any area **do not** meet the standards, and have a hard time understanding those concepts. We will continue to work on these concepts.
