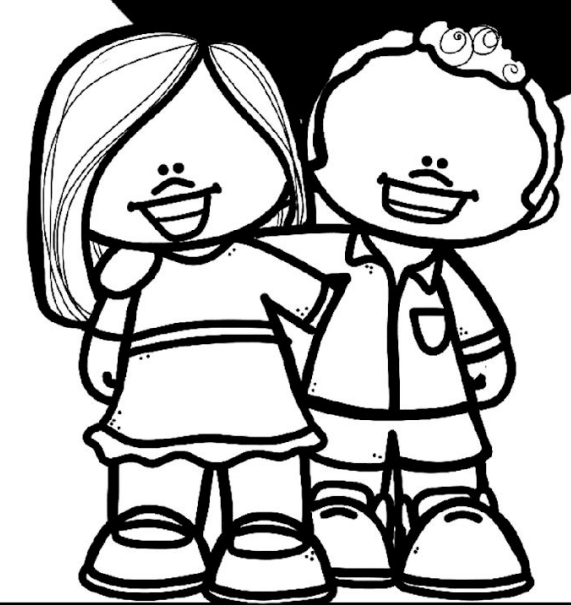

FOLDER/ATTENDANCE

Your student will receive a blue Mustang folder. This folder needs to be brought to and from school everyday. The folder will be used to transport school information and completed school work home. The students will also put unfinished classwork in it to be finished and brought back the following day. Attendance is very important to me.
