4. Principal's Report - Focus for this school year
 - a. Literacy Launch - K-1st grade
 - b. LETRS training is complete
 - c. K-3 teachers are teaching the Really Great Reading curriculum which has a phonics focus.
 - d. Walk to Read - K-6 pull out program is using the 95 Percent curriculum.

- i. This program begins with a quick assessment to help determine skills and reading level for each student. Students are then placed in groups based on what skills they need to work on.
 - ii. Extension groups are provided for students who have mastered the skills to continue their growth in reading as well.
 - iii. Walk to Read is a 30 minute program, Monday through Thursday. Students participate for 15 days and then are re-evaluated. Students are then regrouped for another 15 days.
 - e. Acadience - K-3 testing three times a year to track reading progress.
 - f. PLC Meetings (Professional Learning Community)
 - i. Grade levels meet on Fridays from 1:15-2:00pm
 - ii. Result of PLC meetings: teachers meet to discuss data, plan collaboratively, set goals for students, share teaching strategies.
 - g. Teachers
 - i. Social committee plans a monthly activity for teachers on Friday.
 - ii. Focus on building relationships and getting to know each other - crossword puzzles about staff members.
