## Walk to Read

Our district has implemented a program *called* 95% *Group* that aids in the instruction of foundational literacy skills. "The lessons in this program systematically teach the essential phonics structures that unlock the English code in both simple and complex words."

During the Walk to Read portion of our day, students will be attending groups based on their individual needs. There, they will be working to gain skills needed to produce fluent, more accurate, and more confident readers.

Only 3-5 assessments will be entered into Skyward to determine student's final standards-based grade each grading period.


A form will be sent home on the last Friday of each month to relay student progress.
